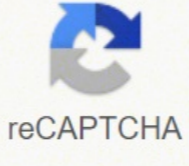

Catfish are more intense in breeding males, and vertical bars may take on a reddish hue. Reaching sexual maturity in three to six years, spawning occurs from late May through August, when the water temperatures reach 75 degrees or better. Flatheads prefer to nest in areas with submerged logs and other debris. Good flathead spots typically include structure, located in relatively deep water ideally with moderate current, and access baitfish. Poor overall health and certain environmental conditions such as drought or flood can reduce flatheads' ability to spawn. Bullheads prefer shallow lakes and slow-moving streams with a soft bottom. Habitat Flathead catfish prefer deep pools of streams, rivers, canals, lakes and reservoirs, where the water is turbid (cloudy) and the currents are slow. Males, like most sunfish, guard the nest. Ahh the joys of childhood and catching bluegills on a bobber and worm...at least that's how it was for us. Flathead catfish are typically pale yellow (hence the name "yellow cat") to light brown on the back and sides, and highly mottled with black and/or brown. As their name suggests, they have flat heads, yet they looks similar to other catfish. The venom is irritating and some people have had serious problems with infection afterward. Young fish may be very dark, almost black in appearance. The back and upper sides are usually dark olive green blending to lavender, brown, copper, or orange on the sides, and reddish-orange or yellow on the belly. Life History Bluegills begin spawning when water temperatures reach about 70°F. May or early June are the typical spawning times, when the bullheads construct saucer-shaped nests in the mud or sand in about 2 to 4 feet of water. Depending on the fish's size, 2,000 to 6,000 eggs are laid. Where mature populations exist, 50-pounders are not unusual. Egg number varies greatly depending on female size, but the average is up to 100,000 eggs at a time. Catfish have long, sharp spines on the front edges of their dorsal fins that are connected to venomous glands. Spawning may peak in May or June, but continues until water temperatures cool in the fall. In healthy times, clutches can reach 100,000 eggs, but only a small number will survive. The anal fin has three spines. The species epithet macrochirus is also Greek and means "large hand" which may refer to the body shape or its size. Pylodictis is Greek meaning "mud fish", and olivaris is Latin for "olive-colored". If females have been eating poorly, their bodies may conserve resources by not releasing eggs. So chances are there's a body of water very close to you that is stocked (and stacked) with bluegill. In Texas, bluegills approaching two pounds have been landed in public waters, and fish over three pounds are known from private tanks. Young fish feed on plankton, but as they grow the diet shifts to aquatic insects and their larvae. But this hard-fighting panfish has a dedicated following, more so than just child's play. Their bluish-black earflap is a distinguishing feature. Equipped with a relatively small mouth, they are nonetheless voracious feeders taking surprisingly large lures. Because of their long spawning season, bluegills have very high reproductive potential, which often results in overpopulation in the face of low predation or low fishing pressure. Nests are created in shallow water, one to two feet in depth. The world record angling record tips the scales at 4 pounds 12 ounces, and adults can grow over 12" long. Adults are usually solitary, each staking out a favorite spot under a tree or in a cove, in deep water. Young flathead catfish feed mostly on invertebrates such as worms, insects and crayfish. At night, they move into shallow areas to feed. The head is broadly flattened, with a projecting lower jaw. When 10 inches or larger, their diet consists entirely of fish-shad, carp, suckers, sunfish, largemouth bass and other catfish (including their own kind). Three subspecies are present: Lepomis macrochirus macrochirus which is native to the northeastern half of the state, Lepomis macrochirus speciosus which is native to the central, southern, and western portions of the state, and Lepomis macrochirus purpurascens, a native of Atlantic coast states which has been introduced widely as a sport and forage fish. "Catfish" is the second most preferred group of fish among licensed Texas anglers, and flatheads rank second behind channel catfish. Bullheads have been known to eat the eggs of other fishes, as well as feeding quite extensively on minnows. Bluegills may be distinguished from other sunfish by the dark spot at the base of the dorsal fin, vertical bars on their sides, and a relatively small mouth. After an incubation period of four to six days, the fry (very young fish) will school together at the nest for several days after hatching; afterwards they will seek shelter beneath rocks, roots and other cover and begin their independent lives. Although the spines can tear skin, the glands excrete venom. They come equipped with a smooth, scaleless skin, barbels, and spines on the dorsal and pectoral fins. Description As the common name suggests, this catfish has a flat head, but other than that, it looks like any other catfish: it has smooth, scaleless skin, whisker-like barbels around the mouth, and long, sharp spines on the dorsal (back) fin and one on each side of the pectoral (shoulder) fin. The spiny dorsal fin usually has 10 spines (but may have as many as 11 or as few as 9), and is broadly connected to the soft dorsal. Typically starting in May or June and they may spawn all summer. As a result bluegills often overpopulate. The tail fin is only slightly notched, not deeply forked as is the case with blue and channel catfish. There are 17 to 20 rays in the anal fin. Their preferred habitats are deep pools, lakes, and large slow-moving rivers. Within these waters they prefer submerged cover such as logs. Males may even improve their selected sites by creating shallow depressions for the females to lay their eggs. Fifty or more nests may be crowded into a small area, thus creating a spawning bed.
